The date value you specified is not a valid calendar date.

PHRASE # 5011 (Kind \$4F00)

The formula you typed is missing a quotation mark as part of a text or date value. \L\LEnclose text and date values in quotation marks.

PHRASE # 5012 (Kind \$4F00)

LisaCalc cannot understand the formula. Break up the formula by placing parts of it in different cells.

PHRASE # 10000 (Kind \$5FFF)
