MENU COMMANDS

FILE

Choose Printer

This command brings up the dialog box that enables you to choose a printer.

Page Setup

You can set the page size, image size and orientation with this menu selection.

Print

Prints picture.

Quit

Exits the program, returns you to the desktop.

Open

Select this item to open a new puzzle. JIGSAW! can open any picture saved in binary or screen format.

Close

Same function as close box, discards current puzzle.

GOODIES

Sound on

You'll hear a tone if you place a piece correctly.

Sound off

Challenge yourself by turning the audio hint off!

Note:

Some sounds will only be available on machines with 1MB+ of RAM.

MENU COMMANDS

PUZZLE

See Picture

You can see a completed puzzle with *See Picture*, time will be added to your time score every time you use this option.

Show High Scores

Displays the current high scores per difficulty level.

Save

This option saves a puzzle in progress.


Restore

This selection will load a saved puzzle. Only one puzzle can be saved at one time!

Restart


Start again using the same puzzle. Reset level.

LEVEL




60 pieces

The ultimate challenge level, for true JIGSAW! puzzle fans.




40 pieces

USING IMAGES

JIGSAW! & other Paint Programs

PaintWorks Gold™

Paintworks files are easily converted. Simply open the file, and use the *SAVE AS...* option. **Save using the screen format option.** JIGSAW! will then be able to load that file.

DeluxePaint II™

DeluxePaint II has a desk accessory that saves DeluxePaint screens. Run DeluxePaint II. The desk accessory called *EA screen-dump*. To access this CDA, just press the Open Apple-Control-Escape keys at the same time. Select *EA screen dump*. Follow the instructions to save the screen image to disk.

Other Products

Many popular products, like ComputerEyes, have the ability to save the screen image. JIGSAW! will load any binary screen or screen format file. There are also public domain and shareware programs available that capture the screen. These are usually available from your local user's group. Please be sure to pay any shareware fee!

Images

Can be opened by other programs for modification and use - just insert the image disk (**make a backup!**), and open it as any other file.

Start JIGSAW!

Insert the JIGSAW! Program disk, and double click on the JIGSAW! icon.

Set the level

Pull down the *LEVEL* menu. Select *8 PIECES*.

Open "ABC"

Pull down the *PUZZLE* menu, and select *OPEN*. Eject the program disk and insert the Image Library disk (Two drive users may simply insert the picture disk into drive 2). Click on *DRIVE*. Use the scroll bars until you can see the "ABC." Select and *Open* "ABC." ABC will appear.

Scramble "ABC"

Mouse click anywhere on the picture. The screen will scramble, and the timer will start.

Move a piece

Mouse click on any piece. Don't drag! Click anywhere else. Note that the first piece and second piece have exchanged places. This is the fundamental move of JIGSAW! If you made a correct move, you'll hear an "audio hint."

Keep moving pieces

Select another piece and click it. This time, guess where it should go, and click there.

See Picture

If you need a visual hint select *See Picture* from the *PUZZLE* menu. This will show the complete picture.

Finish "ABC"

Keep moving pieces until you're finished. Use *See Picture* if you need help.

FASTEST TIMES ARE THE TOP SCORES!**The "Key" piece**

It's a good idea to use a "key" piece to start your puzzle. Look for a prominent feature. Find the corresponding puzzle piece. Put that piece into the right place first - using the audio hint or *See Picture* - then build your puzzle from that piece. Like a building block, you'll find it easier to start this way. Look for a piece that's next to it, and go from there!

Resetting the level

Occasionally, you'll find that the puzzle is too difficult to do at the current level. Change the level, and select *Restart* to start over.

Sound On

Sometimes all you need is an idea of where a single piece should go. Use *Sound On* to tell you when you've moved a piece to the correct place. Remember that using *See Picture* adds to your time!

Before you start

The timer doesn't start until you click on the picture. You should try to memorize as many key features as possible.

Percent complete

You may think that you've finished a puzzle, but the timer will keep on going. The *percent complete* display will tell you how close you are. You may need to use *See Picture*. Find pieces that may be subtly different. Swap pieces that look alike. Remember - puzzles are tricky!
