Rosie woke up. She wiggled her nose. It was a bright, sunny day. It was a great day for a walk.




Rosie looked up at the sky. She counted one cloud.

Rosie hopped on the rocks. She counted four turtles.






Rosie jumped over the water. She counted five frogs.



Rosie felt hungry. She counted six carrots.




Rosie walked in the woods. She counted seven lizards.

She dreamed of frogs and carrots and lizards.




She dreamed of spiders and flowers and butterflies.


