

## Update & Editors Reference Card Apple \* IIGS\* Version

This document contains the specific instructions for the Apple IIgs version of the program which do not appear in the manual. Please read this document before starting the game.

## System Requirements:

Apple IIgs with 1.25 Megabyte of memory One 3.5" disk drive GSOS System 5.0.4 or System 6.0

## Hard Disk Drive Installation:

Boot up your hard drive. Copy the files "Shanghai.II" and "DEPrefs" from Disk 1 to the Shanghai II folder. You should replace the older versions. There have been no changes to the /DE2 disk so you don't have to re-install it. To run the game, double-click on the file "Shanghai.II".

Note: This program uses resource files. Do not use a copy program that is not Finder friendly.

## • Running the game on a 3 1/2" drive only system:

Use your System Disk to boot up either System 5.0.4 or System 6.0. At the Finder, insert the updated Disk One (DE1) and double-click on the file "Shanghai.II". When asked for the DE2 disk use the one from the original Shanghai II program. Please note that on a single drive system, multiple disk swaps will be necessary during game play if sounds are enabled. If you wish to cut down on required disk swaps, please turn sounds off. You can disable the sound effects by choosing "Cancel" when the program asks for disk "DE2".

**Note:** It is important that you make a backup copy of the game for your own personal use. If you are unfamiliar with copying disks, please refer to your Operator's Manual. Use the Backup disks to run the program because the program updates the files on these disks.

• The Tileset and Layout Editors: These programs are located on the tileset & layouts disk. Complete documentation is provided on disk in text files which can be loaded into any word processor or the Teach program.

• New Tileset and Layouts: There are several new tilesets and layouts on the disk. They can be used with Shanghai II by selecting the Custom Layout or Custom Tileset options from the Layout and Tileset menus
