Instructions

Thank you for purchasing an ON THREE product. This disk contains many useful programs and demonstrations taken from the January issue of ON THREE. As a bonus, the back side of the diskette contains all the programs from the February-March issue.

The front side contains Disk Pak1, the utility which will give you up to four extra blocks of disk space; Key-Things, the programs that lets you read the second byte of keyboard data, and all the graphic demos.

To use the program Disk Pak1, simply boot the diskette and follow the instructions. If you wish to use the other programs, transfer them to a copy of your Business BASIC master disk. If you want to use the graphic demos, make sure that the file 'BGRAF.INV' is available on the disk you transfer it to.

The file named 'SYSTEM.STARTUP' on the boot disk can also be transferred to another disk if wanted. However, you must also transfer the file 'SYSTEM.LIBRARY'. If you rename the first file 'D.PAK1.CODE', rename 'SYSTEM.LIBRARY' to 'D.PAK1.LIB'.

In addition to all of the programs in the February-March issue, the back side of the disk contains a program that shows off some of the many available fonts that the Apple /// has to offer. To use, boot a BASIC disk and set the PREFIX\$ to the disk drive with the ON THREE diskette in it. Then type 'RUN FONTDEMO' and the program will display all the fonts on this disk.
