Instructions

Thank you for purchasing an ON THREE product. These diskettes contain many useful programs taken from the Volume 2, Number 1 issue of ON THREE. Both disks are packed with demonstration and utility programs on both sides that you can use.

For complete instructions on how to use the programs on these DOM's please see the Volume 2, Number 1 issue of ON THREE. To use any of the programs on the diskettes, simply boot that disk and follow the instructions on the main menu screens.

These disks are also full of pictures created by Draw ON /// - THE Graphics Tool for the Apple /// and Apple /// plus. To view them, use the utility program DRAW.ON.DEMO on DOM #5. Follow the instructions given and the program will show you some of the beautiful creations of that fine graphics package. After viewing those pictures you will know just why Draw ON /// has become an instant best seller.

To use the Access /// utility program on DOM #5 you will have to do two things. First boot DOM #5 and choose option #5 to exit the menu program. Now type in "LOAD ACCESS3.BASIC". Next change line #'s 140 and 150 to correspond with the numbers you wish to contact. For example, if the 1st number you want to contact is (805) 644-3562 change line 140 as follows:

```
140 PRINT#1"ATD8056443562": GOTO 160
```

Change the other line in a similar manner. When you choose the Access /// option from the DOM #5 menu the program will look for your Access /// Basic Program disk. If it can't find it the program will give you an error message and stop, so remember to put that disk into any drive connected to your ///.

To use the Access /// utility program on DOM #4 you must also do two things. First you have to change the Pascal program ACS3.PAS.TEXT to correspond with the numbers you wish to contact and re-compile it. You will need the Pascal System for the Apple /// to accomplish this. When you are ready to use this program, insert the Access /// Pascal Program disk in any drive connected to your ///.

The Decision Support VisiCalc template is on DOM #5 with the name AIRPLANE.SS. Use it by following the instructions in the Volume 2, Number 1 issue of the magazine. That DOM also contains the PFS - WPL Merge programs with the names PFS.WPL, PFS.WPL.FORMLET, and PFS.WPL.PFSFILE.

To use the Emulation Patch program on DOM #4, simply follow the instructions contained in the program. The program will ask you for the Pascal Unit Number of the drive that contains the Emulation Diskette. If you have started the program off the DOM #5 diskette, the Pascal Unit Number of the built in drive will be #4. If you are running off of a Catalyst system, it will be #5.
