

ON THREE Disk Of the Month #9

Welcome to **ON THREE's** Disk Of the Month #9. The enclosed disk contains programs taken from the pages of **ON THREE Magazine**. You can use the programs by simply starting up your Apple /// with the DOM #9 disk. You will be presented with a menu where you can select the various programs on the disk. To select a program, simply type a number from 1-5. In a moment the program will be loaded from disk and will be displayed on your screen.

Option 1 is the **Easter Egg** graphics demo. This program will display a variety of egg-like pattern on the graphics screen of your Apple ///. To exit press **CONTROL-C**. Then type **RUN HELLO** and press **RETURN**. In a moment the DOM Main Menu will be displayed.

Option 2 is the **Space Convoy** game. This program will give you hours of enjoyment destroying the threatening asteroids. When playing the game the following commands are available:

SPACE-BAR - Fire at the asteroids. You only have 10 shots, so use them sparingly.
ESCAPE - Temporarily pause the action. To resume play, press any other key.
CONTROL-C - Exits. To return to the Main Menu, type **RUN HELLO** and press **RETURN**.

Option 3 and 4 are the **Music Maker** and **Music Player** programs. They allow you to create and listen to music on your Apple ///. To use these programs follow the complete instructions found in the magazine. To select items from the menus in these programs, type the number and then press **RETURN**.

Option 5 is the **Energy Plotting Program**. This program has been modified slightly from the version published in the magazine. For those who wish to use the program, place your data files in the subdirectory **USAGE.DATA** on the floppy disk. When entering information into the program, use the first three letters of the month you would like. For example, **JAN** would suffice for selecting the month of January.

All of these programs can be run from either the built-in floppy disk or a hard disk. To modify them to run from a hard disk, do the following:

- 1) Make a subdirectory on the hard disk to hold the files.
- 2) Copy all of the files from the diskette the subdirectory except **SOS.KERNEL**, **SOS.DRIVER** and **SOS.INTERP**.
- 3) Create a menu item in either Catalyst or Selector per the respective manuals instructions regarding adding a Basic program. Setup the menu item to point to the program **HELLO** in the subdirectory. Make sure to set the prefix to point to the subdirectory.
